Recipe—Chinese Chicken Salad

This recipe is from Jim Nabors' cooking show.

1/2 cup vinegar

2-3 green onions chopped

1/2 cup soy sauce

1 can of sliced water chestnuts

1/4 cup sugar

1/4 cup oil

Lettuce

Chicken chunks poached in White Wine (or water)

Chinese Chow Mein Noodles

Several hours before serving:

1. Combine first four ingredients.
2. Add chicken, green onion and water chestnuts.
3. Refrigerate for several hours.

Just before serving:

4. Spread above mixture over a bed of lettuce.
5. Top with Chinese noodles.

Notes from Business Meeting:

As recorded by the Chronicler

Chatelaine: Phelps County Fair demo: Give Lady Aesa (the Shire Chatelaine) your car make and license plate number if you wish to avoid parking fees. Animals are allowed at this site, but they must have up-to-date rabies tags. Set up is on Friday, the event runs through Sunday. Please use period tents and chairs. The St James Fair demo: This occurs on the same weekend as Kings Company. Please attend if you aren't an archer. We will be encamped between the horseshoe pits and the wine tent.

Exchequer: Shire balance is \$3029.11 as of July 14, 2009. We have upcoming bills, including for the old website. Waivers from events must be kept until the end of the event. The originals go to the Kingdom Waiver Secretary and copies are kept locally. Adult waivers must be kept for seven (7) years, minor waivers must be kept 20 years.

Herald: Currently working on 6 name submissions and a few device submissions. The Herald is in the process of moving and currently lacks email access. This will change soon.

Knight's Marshal: We have a new Fighter Marshal, Torfin Granitethighs. We currently have 17 authorized fighters in the shire, but several are getting pulled away by modern life. Two of our fighters are minors. The deputy in Lebanon is working with

the Parks Board to find a place for fighter practice. If this happens in time, one of the scheduled fighter practices will be moved from my house to Lebanon. Reminder: Upcoming demos are also fighter practices.

Minister of Arts and Sciences: Lord Paul Adler officially takes over from Lady Catin of Edington this month. The Shire Arts and Sciences Champion will be decided at the Shire Picnic. Finally--start working on entries for Queen's Prize!

Autumn Arrows Autocrats: Lord Thomas Fleischer and Lady Catin of Edington are the autocrats. Should the Crown wish to visit, Their Royal Liaison is The Honorable Lady Roselyn of Aberdeen. Feast will be cooked by Lady Cadlae Locha Erne. Archery Marshal in Charge is Baron Jon Tristram. Thrown Weapons line will be run by Lord Gaston de Lurs. Arts and Sciences demos include glass working, demonstrated by Kenny. The autocrats asked the Financial Committee to approve payment for the Mews announcement and Site Deposit. The Financial Committee approved the request.

Seneschal: Support Her Ladyship Rose at Cattle Raids!

Chronicler: Passed out ten hard copies of the July Dancing Moon. Advised people to email if they didn't receive one. Told two people that their addresses were bouncing.

- 1. Beaver Creek Conservation Area:** No Crossbows. From Rolla, take Highway 63 south for several miles. The range gate will be on your left, immediately across the highway from the VFW post. Drive through the gate to the top of the hill, park and take the line!
- 2. Lebanon Library:** From Rolla, take I-44 West to exit 129. Turn North (Right) onto Highway 5/Jefferson. The library will be on the left after you pass Beverly Drive.
- 3. Saint Roberts Municipal Center:** Take I-44 to Exit 161, turn south towards Ft Leonard Wood; at the Arby's, turn left and follow the road past the dollar store. Alternative directions: Follow signs to Drury University St Roberts Campus. The municipal center is in the same building.
